Dear BOMA Fort Worth Member,

Given the increased concerns and circumstances around the Coronavirus, and in response to Governor Abbott's State of Disaster and other recommendations, we wanted to share our plans for BOMA events and committee meetings.

To ensure the safety and well-being of our members, all BOMA Fort Worth events will be **cancelled or postponed through April**. All committee meetings will be held via conference calls until further notice. We will continue to monitor both state and health official recommendations and will communicate scheduling changes with our members. All updates will be shared with our membership via email and on our social media sites.
