

BOMA Fort Worth Allied Membership Renewal Policy | 2017

October 15, 2016

In an effort to assist our Allied Members to get active, participate and build relationships, the Board of Directors established a renewal criteria policy for our Allied Members that went into effect on January 1, 2013.

Each Allied Member must meet three out of the seven criteria starting January 1 through December 31, 2017 to be eligible to renew membership for 2018.

1. Personally attend at least 50% of the BOMA Monthly Luncheons (5 annually). Please note the ten monthly luncheons are included in the annual dues fee.
2. Provide a cumulative \$300 financial sponsorship to one or more of these BOMA activities: Invitational, Bowling Tournament, Dine & Dash, Sporting Clays Tournament, Winter Extravaganza or sponsor a Monthly Luncheon.
3. Purchase a sponsorship at the annual Fall Event or Business Exchange.
4. Volunteer on a BOMA Fort Worth Committee and/or volunteer at a Community Service sponsored Volunteer Day.
5. Bring three (3) non-member property/facility/assistant managers to BOMA functions.
6. Initiate the membership of a Limited Engineer Membership.
7. Initiate the membership of a Principal Member. This can be a new member or a secondary member of a current Principal Member company.

We encourage everyone to join committees, attend events and participate. Remember, BOMA is a marathon, not a sprint. It takes time to build up a customer base, and the only way to do that is to truly be a part of the BOMA Fort Worth community.
